Karunyawet Home for Disabled

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Charity Purpose:

Karunyawet Home for Disabled affiliated with the Social Welfare office, the Department of Social and Welfare Development, Ministry of Social Development and Human Security. Previously, the home had been named "Banglamung Home for Disabilities People" which was officially operated on June 2, 1994. Princess Mahachakri Siridhorn has graciously given new name to the home as Karunyawet Home which means to the home of mercy. Karunyawet Home for Disabled has been established in order to process with its 3 mains objectives following :

1. To provide welfare and assistance to disabled female whose age 18 years upward who have no any contagious diseases, relative who take care and homeless.
2. To provide protection to those disabled and to rehabilitate and develop their potential in order to self-reliance.
3. To support families, communities, local administration organizations on take care disabled persons together.

Its objectives has been settled in response to the home's management policies as follow:

- All disabled would obtain standard social welfare services and potential development in line with their own fundamental right.
- Having standard theme and management method of social welfare services and social development provision.
- Fostering network participation on welfare provision to disabled.
- Having development theme on management and services provision system.

Review Process:

Ms. Jittra Temesuk, the Home's director has given an Annual Report year 2014 through an affiliate of Giving Back Association after the affiliate has visit the home late January 2015. Karunyawet Home for Disabled would be the first governmental home for disabled that Giving Back Association make review.

Background to the need:

Karunyawet Home for Disabled is supported by the Ministry of Social Development and Human Security, its budget would be allocated in line with the government policy each year. Karunyawet Home for Disabled has its 4 core missions in order to serve and provide social welfare as details below :

1. **To operate social welfare for disabled who stay in the home** which include :
 - Resident welfare for disabled which include raising for daily living, meal, and all necessary living facilities.
 - Social welfare services such as giving advice, counselling, and troubleshooting both individual and group basis in addition to recreation activities and funeral.
 - Health promotion with first aid, delivering to hospital including preparation of medical treatment for individual patient.
 - Promotion of development by group activities, development stimulation, daily living skill training, self-reliance in difficult situation and helping other etc.

- Sport skill promotion by providing sport specialist to conduct sport skill training with sending its staff to obtain sport skill training courses.
- Providing career to disabled including coordinating with other business entities.

2. Social welfare provision to disabled in communities.

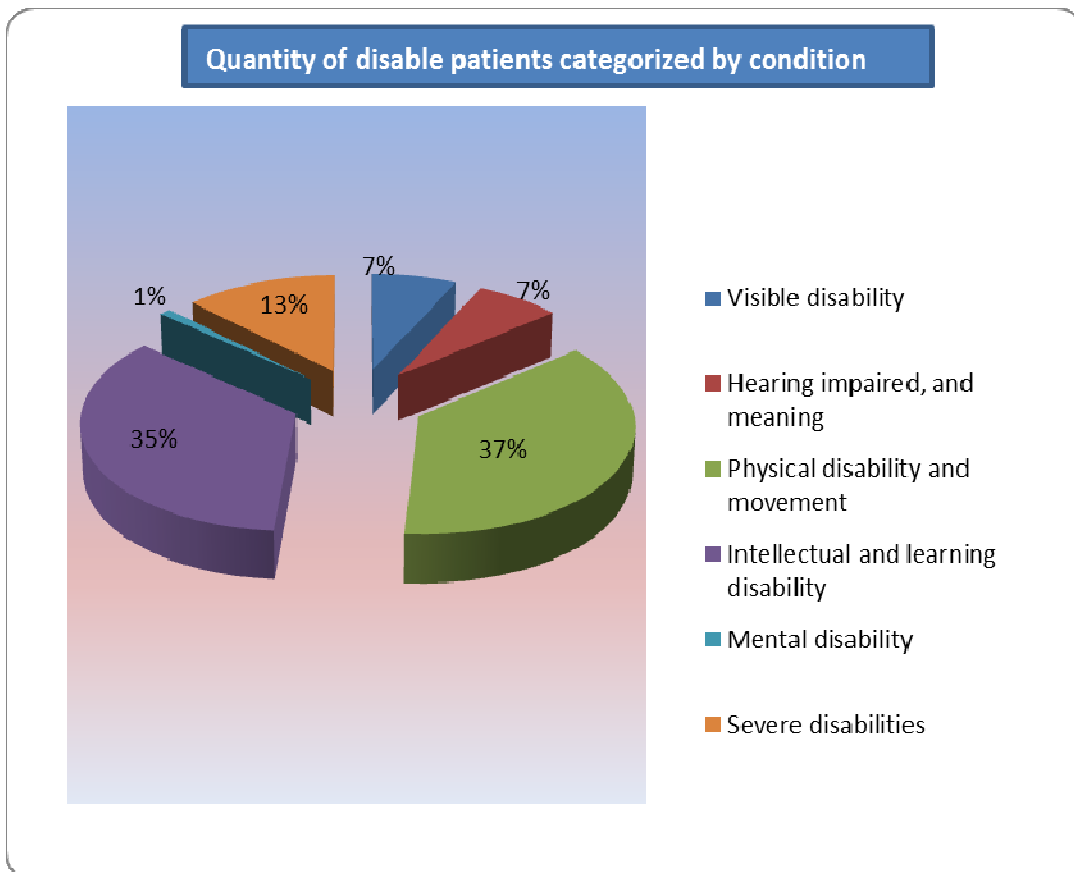
- Financial support for rehabilitation to disable people.
- Provision of prosthesis to disabled.
- Creating residential development project for disable people in communities.
- Services of advice, counselling on social welfare in communities.

3. Learning Center on welfare for disabled management in order to give opportunity to education institute, private sector, local administrative member group and people who are interested to obtain experiences of social welfare for disabled management to further apply in their own communities.

4. The center of counselling and referrals. This services is provide both internal and external disabled who are in trouble including people involved.

As of September 30, 2014 there were female disabled who have been served by the home detail following :

Description of Activities and Programs:

Services Provision in Karunyawet Home for Disabled consists of :

- 1 Parenting Services** which including daily living take care, residential and meals provision and other necessary facilities for daily living provision.
- 2 Medical and health care services**, the home provides 24 hours nursing services, care-taker in order to take care on sanitation and first aid. In case of chronic illness or the illness beyond to the home's capacity, those patient will be referred to the near by hospital for appropriate medical treatment.
- 3 Social welfare services**, the home provides social worker to stay in each disabled dormitory in order to advice and solve problem for patients and their families by individual and/or group basis using activities to solve the problem caused by the patient's behaviour including coordination with the patients families and legal process for disability privilege.
- 4 Physical therapy**, the home has provided physical therapist to rehabilitate and restore potential of disable patient including prosthesis or individual disability aids as necessity.
- 5 Occupational therapy services**, to support those disabled to activate with vocational training in response to each individual skill which is not only a channel to increase income but also release daily stress.
- 6 Development stimulation services**, in order to promote daily living development such as skill of self-reliance, skill of emotion and social, skill of house keeping, cooking, learning and refreshing mind.
- 7 Vocational training services**, the home coordinates with other organizations both governmental and private sectors in order to send disabled who are in work ability condition to obtain vocational training courses which appropriate with the disability condition such as cooking, clothing, beauty salon for example.
- 8 Sports, recreation, field trips and activities organizing for disabled services provision**, this is to change atmosphere environment for disable patient who stay in the home and to contribute constructive activities to the surround communities.
- 9 Funeral services**, the home provides this service for those disable patients who have no relative or their relative are in poverty. The funeral will be arranged in line with patient's religion.

Primary Supporting Organisations:

- Social Welfare office, the Department of Social and Welfare, the Ministry of Social Development and Human Security.
- Karunyawet foundation for disabled.

Transparency and reporting

Karunyawet Home for Disabled has directly report to the Department of Social Welfare Development, Ministry of Social Development and Human Security, it is a part of governmental social services provision to disable person. Its financial status is in form of government budget allocation and budget spending which need to base on balanced statement. There were some insignificant expenses which were out side budget.

Karunyawet Home for Disabled need to annually arrange budget spending report to its original affiliation.
